Retinal Screening

If you decline the Wellness Screening, please choose (1) of the following other options

I request the Optomap examination as my retinal screening instead of dilation at an out-of-pocket expense of \$45.

I request the Optomap examination as a medical necessity, due to diabetes, high blood pressure, glaucoma, thyroid condition, retinal pathology, floaters, or any other significant medical condition. The Optomap exam is billed to your medical insurance policy. Most insurance companies require a second visit to have the Optomap exam billed for medical conditions. You can expect to pay your usual medical copay, not to exceed \$45.

I request dilation as my retinal screening and I acknowledge that this is performed after all other testing is complete, including contact lens services. I understand that dilation will require an additional testing of at least 30-minutes to complete the eye exam and that my eyes will remained dilated for approximately 8-hours.

Macular Pigment Density

The Quantifeye examination is a computerized test that measures a person's macular pigment density which is helpful in diagnosing the risk of Macular Degeneration. Patients with a high risk of developing macular degeneration can be treated by adding specially formulated nutritional supplements to their diets.

You should consider taking the QuantifEye test if you:

- Have a family history of macular degeneration
- Smoke, or have ever smoked
- Are above the age of 20
- Are "fair" skinned
- Are overweight or have an unhealthy diet
- Suffer from cardiovascular disease
